SUL BADGES

Each badge is earned by completing a set of requirements, so students should read the rules carefully to make the most of it:

During SUL's Awards Ceremony, held at the end of the week, the team that accumulates the most points will be declared the SUL League Champion, receiving the Goblet of the Sun and an eternal place in SUL's Hall of Champions! After SUL's Awards Ceremony, all teams' points reset to zero, and a new SUL League begins.

PERSONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

However, the excitement continues beyond team glory. Every point students earn counts towards their personal achievements. This means they're not just star players on their teams; they're also building a stellar reputation for themselves. Each badge they collect brings them one step closer to individual awards and prizes.

During SUL's Awards Ceremony, if a student earns the necessary points, they will be awarded the respective SUL badge(s), and the points relative to that specific badge will reset. 
