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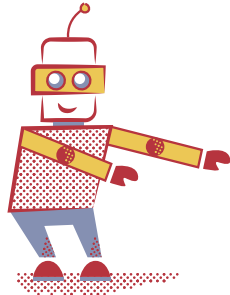

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We are an independent educational organisation with more than 40 years' experience in helping young learners re-discover their joy in learning.



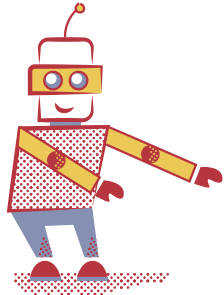

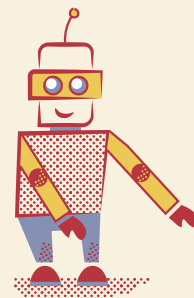
The language content is tailored to the programme. We work closely with our teachers to ensure all students gain confidence leaving the UK and feel more assured about using English for real-life, authentic situations.

MSC Preziosa is a Fantasia-class cruise ship owned and operated by MSC Cruises. She entered service in March 2013. MSC Preziosa is 333 m (1,092.52 ft) long, the moulded breadth of the hull 37.92 meters and the draught 8.45 metres. She accommodates up to 4,363 passengers with a crew complement of 1,325. She has 13 passenger decks, which contain 1,310 outside cabins and 327 inside cabins. Her speed is quoted at 23 knots (43 km/h; 26 mph).

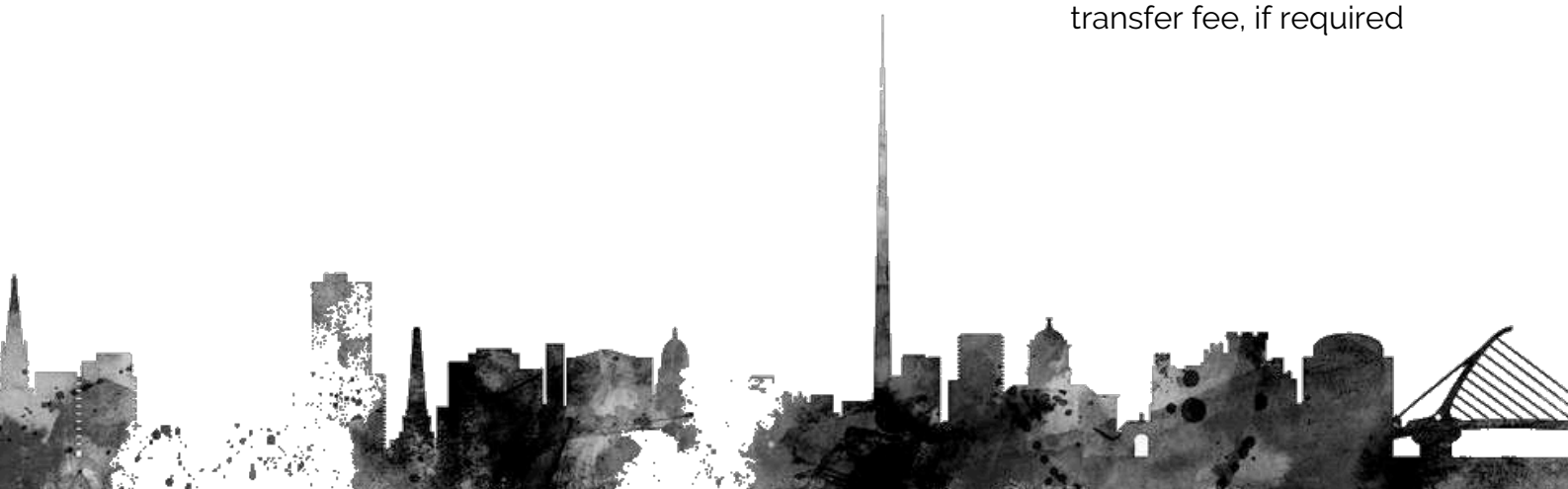

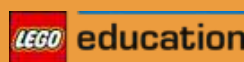
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
